
At this phase of the project, the knowledge paper and the modular curriculum were published. Partners will translate the teacher guide and modular curriculum. The OER course will also be translated by BETI. In addition, the project partners reflected on the series workshops and the conducted surveys on digital pedagogy. Furthermore, the partners collaborated to plan for the e-teach certificate program, set up important deadlines for updating the teacher guide and the OER course, and organize the schedules of the multiplier events.

TEACHER'S GUIDE

The Teacher's Guide is an online resource that will be designed to provide teachers and future teachers with practical tools and strategies for integrating digital pedagogy into their classrooms.

Drawing from the recommendations discussed, there's a collective commitment to refining and finalizing the modules of the Teacher's Guide in September 2023. Furthermore, to cater to a diverse audience, the translated version of the teacher guide will be available in October 2023.



(OER) ONLINE COURSE

The OER Online Course is a specialized platform designed to cater to the needs of current teachers and aspiring teachers who aim to refine their skills in digital pedagogy. Accessible through the Canvas platform, this course will offer a wealth of high-quality Open Educational Resources (OER) in an interactive and user-friendly environment.

The e-Teach OER online course will be published and available to the public in October 2023.



E-TEACH CERTIFICATE TRAINING PROGRAM

The e-teach certificate training program features a blend of live, online synchronous training sessions with an asynchronous online course (OER). Our partners will host four distinct 2-hour sessions focusing on various facets of digital pedagogy.









E-TEACH CERTIFICATE TRAINING PROGRAM

The program aims:

- To create a supportive and enriching environment for educators and future teachers.
- To offer a robust curriculum covering the many facets of digital pedagogy.
- To provide the necessary skill set for effectively leveraging digital tools and methods in teaching.
- To offer a certificate, serving as a credential for digital pedagogical competence.

The e-teach certificate training program consists of 4 sessions according to the following schedule:

- Session 1: October 17, 2023
- Session 2: October 24, 2023
- Session 3: October 31, 2023
- Session 4: November 7, 2023
