
The third face-to-face meeting within the Erasmus+ project EcoDigi will be hosted in Zaragoza, Spain on 22nd February 2024.

Between 19th and 21st February 2024 adult educators and trainers will have the opportunity to gain valuable insights through a variety of engaging workshops.

The aim of LTTA is to build a pool of skilled master trainers, who will be able to return to their countries and support the strengthening of adult educators' capacities to improve the sustainability and accessibility of their practices.


The training will take place over a 3-day period in Spain, in-person, as this is the most effective way to enhance their skills and training expertise.

## RESULTS

### Online Platform and Database

Partners prepared an online database presenting existing resources (lesson plans, reports, tools, good practice examples) relating to the themes of sustainability and inclusivity. All the collected materials are available on the project platform [HERE](#). The resources are related to the 6 topics:

1. SDG goals, essence and specifics in relation to adult education/training provision,
2. Raising the awareness and relevance of digital sustainability: printing policies, waste management, energy efficiency,
3. Inclusion of learners in the adult education practices, contemporary trends,
4. Modes of provision and applicability to adult education sustainable practices,
5. Accessibility as organizational strategy for adult educators/training providers,
6. Ethical policies and Code of Conduct as tools for ecological and digital adult education sustainability.

### Guidelines for Adult Educators:

#### Promoting Environmental Sustainability and Accessibility in the Digital World

Currently, partners are working on Guidelines - a practical guide for educators on improving their practices. The emphasis will be placed on "practical" as the guidelines contain very specific ideas and easy steps, which allow them to be relevant to a wide pool of educators in different situations.
